

McMillan Grade Refresh

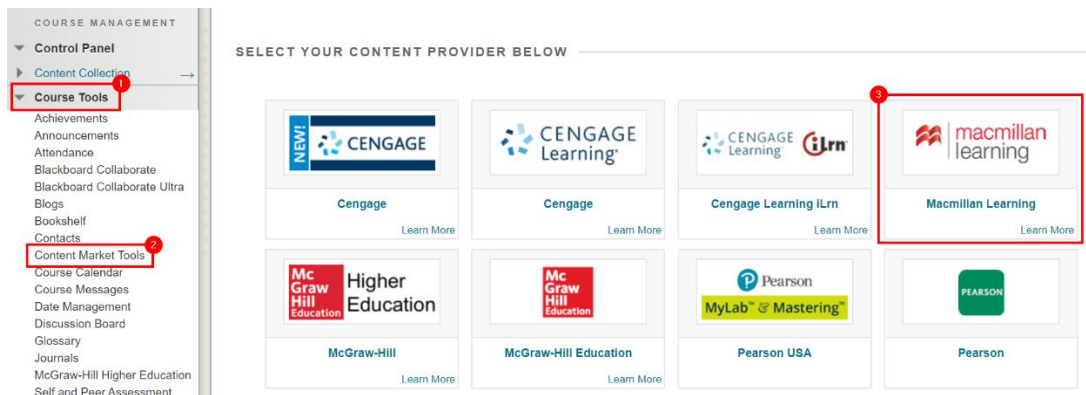
Grades in your Blackboard course will update automatically to match your Macmillan gradebook. However, grades often take several hours to update. If you need your grades to appear in Blackboard immediately, you can use the **Manual Grade Refresh** support tool. You can refresh grades at any time. It won't interfere with the automated gradesync.
